- We reserve the right to **pair** twosomes and singles and if needed to **move your tee time one time forward or back**.
- FIVESOMES are not permitted at any time.
- We advise that golfers should arrive at least **15-minutes prior** to their tee time. We strive to be on-time all day.
- Personal coolers & outside alcoholic beverages <u>are not</u> <u>permitted</u> anywhere on the premises.
- All players must have their own set of clubs. Rentals are available
 in the Pro Shop

- Pro Shop staff cannot match online rates.

Cancellation – NO SHOW Policy

- All reservations whether online or over the phone require a valid credit card
- Credit cards are to hold the reservation and will not be charged except for the following reasons:

Reservation is canceled or modified inside **24 hours** of tee time. Players are not present for their tee time or tee time was not properly modified before **24** hours.

Example: If you **do not show** for tee time you will be **charged the full amount**. If you book for four and show up with 3 you will be charged for 4.

 All reservations may be canceled or modified by calling 863-420-1724. 24 hours a day.

Pace Of Play

- We strive to keep our pace of below 4 Hours to ensure as many people can enjoy 18-Holes of golf as possible.
- See scorecard for **hole pace expectations**. Our team of Rangers and Starters do their best to enforce and educate the players on this policy in a friendly manner, we appreciate your cooperation!
- The expected pace of play is 4 hours for 18-Holes, but we understand sometimes pace is not always attainable.

Dress Code On The Golf Course

Golf Cart Rental Policies

- A valid driver's license is **required** to operate a golf cart.
- No one under the age of 16 can operate golf cart.
- No more than 2 riders may occupy a golf cart at any time.
- Golf carts need to stay on Golf Course Property.
- Golf Carts are not to enter homeowners' private property for any reason.
- The person who signs for the cart will be held responsible for any damages during the round.
